In addition the Company carries a wide range of external envelope works including Aluminium Composite and Timber fenestration, Curtain Walling, Roof Repairs, Disability Adaptations, Asbestos Removals, Cladding and Environmental Works.

Radway Door and Windows Ltd is committed to reduce the impact on the external environment by complying with relevant legislations, setting objectives and measurable targets to reduce the energy consumption and volumes of waste generated by developing more efficient activities using sustainable energy and materials where ever possible.

In addition the Company reviews all of its products, processes, services and business systems in order to minimise waste in any form, prevent pollution and aim to provide low carbon products and services.

The Environmental Team is assigned with ensuring that risks associated with business operations are assessed, prioritised and that appropriate actions are taken to manage the environmental impact. The Company strives to identify and control environmental aspects by monitoring, measuring, analysing and implementing actions against the numerous linked procedures as part of an ongoing continual improvement programme.






In preparation of action plans, employee involvement is encouraged from the organisation to continually consider environmental aspects and spread improvements to the working environment. To ensure that each member of staff is aware and supports the importance of this policy within their roles and responsibilities, appropriate training and resources is also provided.

Radway encourages its suppliers to comply with existing legislation and to act responsibly with regard to the environment and occupational health & safety; the Company subsequently uses appropriate evaluation and selection procedures in the supply chain protocol, towards membership of suitable sustainable sourcing accreditation schemes.

The Integrated Management System, Environmental Policy and Key Performance Indicators are reviewed annually at the Management Review Meeting by the Senior Management team and Board to ensure continued suitability and effectiveness in relation to Company objectives.

By operating and maintaining a certified Environmental Management System to BS EN ISO 14001, Radway aims to achieve continual improvement of its environmental impact.
